## MIGOSI FAMILY HOPE SOCIETY SPONSORSHIP JOURNEY MANUAL.

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### **OUR VISION;**

Our Vision for every child, is Education, Good health, Life, Care and Love Through trust in our Motto; EDUCATION IS POWER. We partner to end child poverty.

In 2006 Migosi Family Hope Society was known as Migosi Family Focus Self-Help Group. Its main purpose then, being street children rehabilitation program, which was geared towards education and rehabilitation of children in the street and those in Juvenile prison in Kisumu town, Western Kenya. It all started through Building of Trust and Skills among the children in the streets and the organization itself. This came in through a street session and Juvenile session which we carried every Sunday to help reach the children and give them support psychologically and even offer food through our feeding program and Clothing. Before Migosi Family Hope Society came in the street and prisons of Kisumu, It was a NO GO ZONE for anyone who was believed not to be part of the street life and Education was out of the question for most children who spent their days fighting and doing child labour, Just to get a meal. Through our MOTTO; S.E.E.D (Socialise. Educate. Empower and Develop) we managed to obtain trust among us and the children and this has grown over the years, with a strong belief that Migosi Family Focus Self-Help group bore Migosi Family Hope Society in the year 2010 with the government support through the Ministry of Gender, Children and Social Development. The two groups still work together and now in full partnership with MIGOSI FAMILY HOPE AUSTRIA which is based in AUSTRIA. the three groups have changed lives of Children in the street, in Juvenile prison, In slum areas, Women with HIV/AIDS, and youths of Kisumu in general. Through Agriculture, Family planning sessions, growth and development sessions, shoe making for youths, we managed to reach families and children Indigenous and other as we worked to meet immediate needs through these projects. Community meetings and meetings with elders and leaders were also key parts of the process.

In 2008 after the dreadful post-election violence that left thousands dead, Hundreds of thousands homeless, and many children were orphaned through this, we moved to the Building of Hope project that was piloted by the community members in Kasule, Ogango slum who helped in Building a slum school, that was geared towards offering children with free nursery school education and sponsorship. This was also a center where we would identify children with special abilities and needs then sponsor them to attain more education and better their lives in future. We encountered many challenges and this we used the community's support in tackling each and every bit of this challenges. Many people began to see change in these children and many children ran away from home just to attend a class session at the nursery school.

We had to look through four programs that we were now given the mandate to run by the government and that was Health, Education, Environment and Empowerment. We have managed to build confidence for the future of the children we had, and the women who were in our center and all this was through the effort of the two groups MIGOSI FAMILY HOPE SOCIETY and MIGOSI FAMILY HOPE AUSTRIA. However our efforts of sponsoring individual children in PRIMARY and SECONDARY SCHOOL would have not been seen without the sponsors who came in to support each and every child that we identified and took in.

The Care that is provided to these children and even their families by a sponsor enables many children and their families to focus on their future goals and not only survival. Many of these children have grown to believe that they have Hope and trust that one day life will change and Migosi Family Hope Society will be able to care for other children too. Sponsoring a child brings change and acts as a tool for growth and development. One who sponsors a child helps the entire family and makes it possible for them to eventually help and support others in their community.
